1. Rules and Regulations: [CDI Rules]

You will have registered all participants and alternates with no add-ins on the day of the Convention.

The CDI Kahoot Tech teams will have a sponsor/coach available during the competition. Also, each team will have three official members and one alternate for the competition.

Depending upon the number of registered and present teams we will have a bracket of competitions, and the CDI Kahoot Tech Champion will be the one with the highest points at the end of the final round. There is only a continuous winner's bracket. One team will be declared the champion. This team will be awarded at the end of the day.

The Kahoot Tech Coordinator will serve as a judge for this competition and will make all final decisions regarding questions and scoring. The Kahoot Tech Coordinator will maintain possession of individual round questions before each match-up. The specific Kahoot Tech questions will be distributed to the team sponsors. The questions will then be returned to the Kahoot Tech Coordinator following the final question and scoring posted.

Each church may recruit and train its team on ALL questions. During competitions, the sponsor/coach may move players as needed to fill vacancies. (i.e., needs to leave for other CDI Sunday School Convention competitions). Therefore, it is imperative to have all participants and alternates on your roster and available to compete when called upon.

Sponsors/Coaches are to provide name cards so that the Kahoot Tech Coordinator may call on students by name and church.

2. Rules and Regulations: [General Competition Rules]

Each contest features two teams of three players and an alternate on standby. Each unit has one captain to participate in all the rounds. To be an eligible contestant the youth, must be 12 years old up to 17 years of age.

Each contest will consist of one round of 15 questions. Teams accumulate points by giving correct answers to questions. Should a response be interjected from the audience, the question may be discarded at the Kahoot Tech Coordinator's discretion.

All questions are electronically generated through the Kahoot App that the captain of the team will download to his/her phone. The team can participate in answering the question but the captain of the team will be responsible for answering the question in the App.

Appeals regarding answers to questions may be made by either the sponsor/coach or players. The Kahoot Tech Coordinator shall hear appeals only at the end of each game. Decisions of the Kahoot Tech Coordinator shall be final. The official declaration of the outcome and the contest score shall be irrevocable.

There will be only two teams playing in any given round and the team with the highest points move down the bracket to play the next. This will continue until there is just one team declared a winner.

3. Rules and Regulations: [Code of Conduct]

Because of the nature of any form of competition, the atmosphere of Kahoot Tech contests should be challenging and intense. However, mutual respect should always prevail, and teams should be taught that appropriate behavior is an all-important part of the competition. Players should not be encouraged to regard good sportsmanship as an option. With its unique combination of public, large, and small churches, the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church Youth Ministries should encourage its youth, sponsor/coach, and representatives to form unities, friendships/brotherhoods, beyond the confines of their own churches and communities.

If any misconduct is observed by anyone in the competition area the Kahoot Tech Coordinator will bring the accusations to the sponsor/coach and representatives. The Kahoot Tech Coordinator will ask them to take further action. The Kahoot Tech Coordinator will recommend what action should be taken which could range from a formal apology to those offended up to possible disqualification from the competition. All parties will be informed and asked to cooperate in the procedure as having been given prior notice.
