Jeopardy! Teams

1. A team will be chosen randomly to select a category and the value. For example, a team might say "Animal 200," which means that they have selected the animal category and the 200-clue value card.
2. The clue, which is in the form of an answer, will be read out.
3. After listening to the clue, the teams will get 10 seconds to discuss their answer.
4. The team that presses the buzzer or raises their hand first, will get a chance to answer.
5. The answer should be in the form of a question.
6. If that team answers correctly, the value of that clue is awarded to the team.
7. If the team gives an incorrect answer, those points will be subtracted from their score, and another team will get the chance to answer.
8. The round continues till all questions are answered.

Jeopardy! Player(s)

1. A player(s) will select a category and the value. For example, a player might say "Animal 200," which means that they have selected the animal category and the 200-clue value card.
2. The clue, which is in the form of an answer, will be read out.
3. After listening to the clue, the player(s) will get 5 seconds to discuss their answer.
4. The player that presses the buzzer or raises their hand first, will get a chance to answer.
5. The answers should be in the form of a question.
6. If that player(s) answers correctly, the value of that clue is awarded to the other player.
7. If the player(s) gives an incorrect answer, those points will be subtracted from their score, and another player will get the chance to answer.
9. The round continues till all questions are answered.
